

Setting Up & Dismantling:

- 1-2 x professional pool player over the course of the event
- 1 x overseer to ensure the event runs smoothly
- 1-5 x volunteers to help with collections
- 1-5 x Hearing Dogs so people can see visually what cause they are donating to
